Tool objectives:

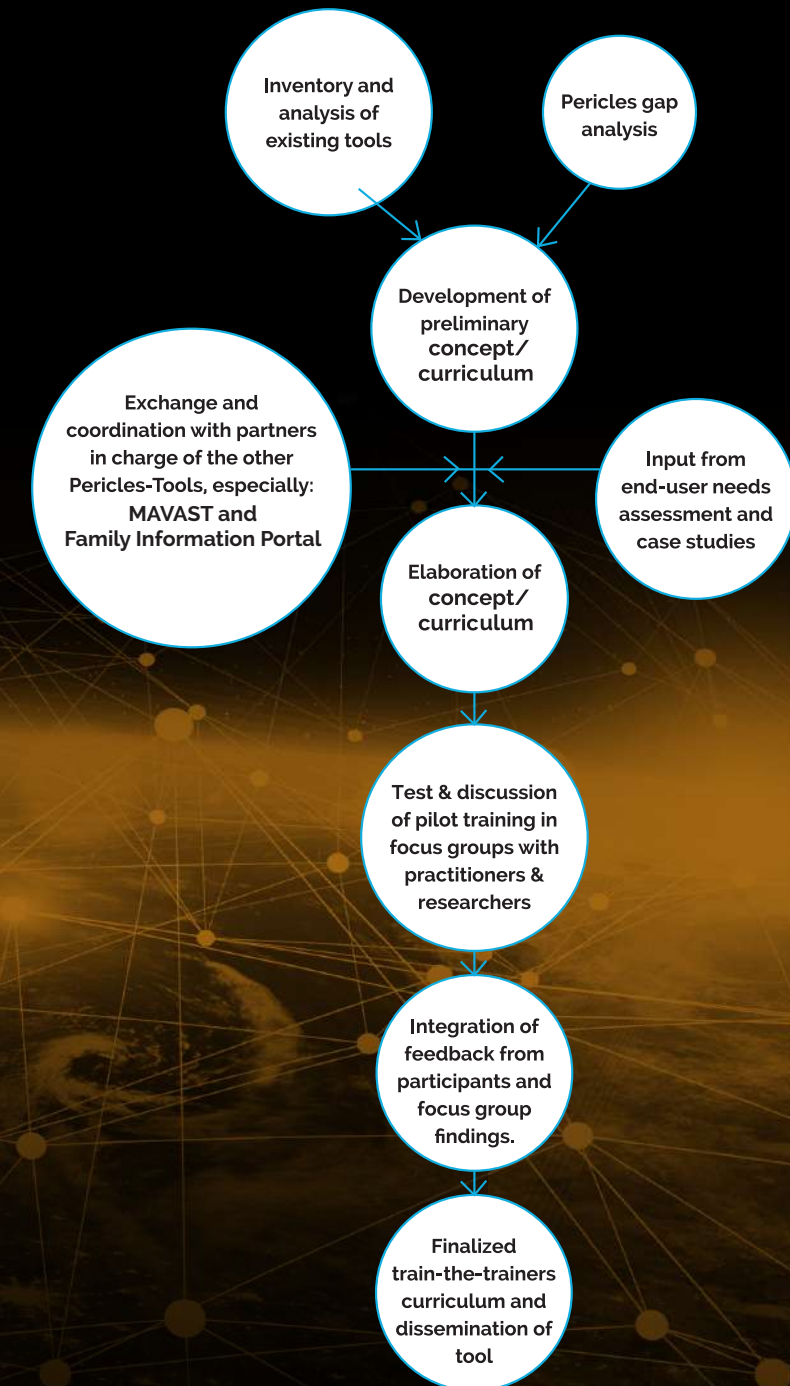
The Enhanced Platform is a public facing web-based tool that hosts or provides a guided access point to all the other PERICLES project tools. It achieves this through an intuitive interface for easy navigation of the tools and their related functions. It makes use of a database necessary for the complex computation of the Decision Support function and related information that is relayed to the platform. The EP also houses a Further Resources Tab containing:

- Sister Projects;**
- Lessons Learned;**
- Gender Hub; and**
- Interactive Map**

Overview of approach to development/methodology:

The initial mapping was restricted to selected case study regions/communities /environment which was used to show how the concept will be operationalised. This task enabled tool set up to visualise the mapping done by a criteria elicitation methodology. It identifies and maps the relevant actors, their objectives, their potential roles and the relationship to each other on the basis of shared criteria.

The platform provides additional further resources and helpful guides, assisting the end user with finding the relevant information they are looking for or simply facilitating a general introduction into radicalisation and the various sources of support available across Europe and beyond.
